

## COVID-19 UPDATE

First Tee of Greater St. Louis is taking necessary safety precautions to protect our participants, parents, and staff during our classes. We will be adhering to state, local and golf course guidelines, in addition to those outlined below. It is the sole responsibility of each person present to make an informed decision about their attendance of a First Tee of Greater St. Louis class. Our priority is to keep everyone as safe as possible and for our classes to be enjoyable for everyone involved.

We will work to ensure that best practices for cleaning and sanitizing are being followed at our program locations. Our staff, coaches, and volunteers will be wearing face masks and remain vigilant in practicing good hygiene and we encouraging all others involved to do the same.

### WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FOR YOUR FIRST TEE SESSION:

- Participants must not arrive more than 10 minutes before class.
- Each program location will have a designated check in site. You will be notified of your check in site before class starts.
- Parents are required to check their child in upon arrival. Please observe 6 ft social distancing while waiting to check in.
- There will be a brief health screening at check-in. (questionnaire and/or temperature check)
- We suggest but will not require participants to wear a mask.
- Participants are required to wash or sanitize their hands before and after class activities.
- Participants MUST use the restroom BEFORE class, there will be no on-course restrooms or restroom usage during class.
- Participants will be assigned a bag of equipment to use during class that they MUST bring to each class (clubs, balls, nametag, yardage book, pencil, etc.). There will be no sharing of equipment.
- Participants must bring their own prefilled water bottle.
- Participants are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizer to keep in their equipment bag.
- Participants will be assigned to groups of no more than 10 (including coaches and participants).
- All participants are required to maintain physical distancing of at least 6 feet at all times.
- Parents are encouraged to stay for the entirety of the class and observe from a distance prescribed by coaches and maintain a safe social distance from others. Please bring a chair; many of the patios and pavilion areas are closed.
- Parents must check their child out at the end of class.

Please note that these policies and procedures may be amended, changed, updated or deleted based on the course directives, the CDC guidelines and the rules put in place by our state and local government. It is our goal to meet all of these guidelines while still providing the best experience possible. Should you notice one of the policies not being followed, please try and politely resolve the issue with our coaches.
